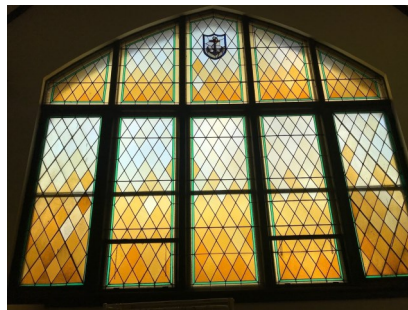


PPUMC is a RECONCILING CONGREGATION

The Word of God for the people of God (All: Thanks be to God)

2 Hannah prayed and said,
"My heart exults in the LORD;
my strength is exalted in my God.
My mouth derides my enemies
because I rejoice in your victory.
2 There is no Holy One like the LORD,
